Saving a design for sewing


Once you have edited, digitized a design or simply created text. You are now ready to send the design to your embroidery machine. First you will need to make sure "embroidery" from the top drop down menu is selected.



Then select "center design" at the top of your screen




Next you will select start/end, highlight start point and select start point at first section.



Then you will select start/end again and highlight end point. Then end point at center.




This will center your design and start sewing at the first section that was digitized. Then it will end back at the center of the design. This makes it easier when you are doing a multiple order of the same design. Place your USB key in an available spot on the computer. It is best to use a 1GB or 2GB USB key. Your SWF embroidery machine cannot read a 4GB USB key or higher.

Next we will select the Universal icon at the top left of the screen.



Then highlight save file and select export as embroidery machine format.



Select the USB key option from the drop down menu.
